

**TOWN OF MOSEL
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING WITH
WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

SEPTEMBER 3, 2008

MINUTES

- I. Call To Order and Verification of Meeting Duly Noticed.** Town Chair Dirk Zylman called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. at the Mosel Town Hall, W982 County Road FF, Sheboygan. Other Town officials present were Supervisors Dave Scharinger and Wayne Warnecke, and Clerk-Treasurer Rachel Rehbein. Also present Jay Schickel and Paul Brauer and David Nielsen of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT). Clerk-Treasurer Rehbein confirmed proper notice of the meeting.
- II. Discussion on future plans for access along State Highway 42.** Mr. Bauer and Mr. Nielsen will provide the Town with the access points being planned and their standards for access points on the Town of Mosel section of Highway 42. DOT will make frontage roads on freeways if necessary for the flow of traffic. Hwy 42 possibly could become a 4-way in the future (2020). Mr. Bauer and Mr. Nielsen stated the Town should look at their road system. The DOT limits access points and left hand turns to keep roundabouts moving smoothly. The Town can add crossroads if DOT has a working project in that area. When business development comes in, the Town could possible have “backage” roads that need to be 500 feet from Hwy 42. The roundabout at Garton and Hwy 42 will be let in January 2009 and construction will begin May 2009. Mr. Bauer and Mr. Nielsen were unsure if the roundabout at Y and Hwy 42 would be done at the same time. DOT will have future public hearings. DOT standards require 2,000 feet space between roads. Jay Schickel can have a 33 ft. driveway onto Hwy 42. It cannot be a road because it is not within the 2,000 ft. requirement.
- III. Adjourn.** Motion Scharinger/Warnecke to adjourn; carried 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:28 a.m.
