## E-WASTE/E-CYCLE LAW

Wisconsin's electronics recycling law went into effect January 2010. This law requires manufacturers of certain consumer electronics to assume financial responsibility for the collection and recycling of used electronics. Your old electronics should be recycled at the time of your new purchase.

**Beginning September 1, 2010, you can no longer bring the following electronics to the Transfer Station:**

- Computers
- Computer monitors
- Printers
- Computer keyboards
- Computer mice
- Televisions
- VCRs
- DVD players
- DVRs
- Telephones with video displays
- Fax Machines
- Other video display devices

As a Sheboygan County resident you can bring your old electronics to the Sheboygan County's 2010 Clean Sweep which will be held at the following locations and times:

Sheboygan County Highway Dept.-Southside Shed, 7614 Frontage Road, Sheboygan  
March 20, 8-11 a.m. / May 14, 1-6 p.m. / September 18, 8-11 a.m.

Sheboygan County Highway Dept.-Cascade Shed, W6451 State Highway 28, Cascade  
May 15, 8-11 a.m.

Sheboygan County Highway Dept.-Plymouth Shed, N6111 County Road OJ, Plymouth  
July 17, 8-11 a.m. / November 6, 8-11 a.m.
